## **Police Report**

During the month of October 2018 Wymeswold had 4 x Vehicle crime's reported which mainly consisted of individuals trying car doors and theft from motor vehicle.

### **Planning Update**

The appeal against the decision to refuse permission for up to 25 houses to be built on Land off Burton Lane, planning reference P/16/1852/2 was heard on 24<sup>th</sup> October at the Ramada Hotel in Loughborough. The appeal was condensed into one day, from the two planned days. The Parish Council's statement was presented by our Borough Councillor Jenny Bokor. At the time of writing the inspector had still not issued a decision. Any results will be posted on our website as soon as they are available.

#### **Prestwold License**

The Clerk, Cllr Cooke and Cllr Bokor attended the Prestwold license review meeting to represent Wymeswold. Prestwold accepted that the 'Forbidden Forest' event was badly managed causing noise and traffic issues in the Wolds villages. After much discussion it was agreed that Prestwold can retain their license but new conditions need to be complied with. The key change is the reduction in the permitted noise levels for all future events on the Prestwold Estate. A limit of 15dBa above background noise levels has been confirmed which would limit noise levels to 40-50dBa. Levels higher than 65dBa were recorded at the September event.

#### **Remembrance Day**

Remembrance Day saw the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of WW1. The village looked fantastic decorated with lamp post poppies and the 'Silent Soldiers' throughout the village were very poignant. Peter and Lesley Blount along with their team worked tirelessly to help commemorate our fallen soldiers from the village – a big thank you to them.
